How to Submit Artwork:

For consideration, all applicants must be diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder and at least 18 years of age. All artists must submit a completed submission form, along with accompanying photo or video for each piece being submitted. A maximum of three pieces can be submitted for each artist and can include, but is not limited to, video and projection work, painting, 3-D sculpture, and installation work.
